Biography

Jackson Slattery lives and works between Montreal and Melbourne, Australia. In 2004, Slattery received his BFA in Drawing from RMIT University. Slattery has shown extensively both nationally and internationally. Recent exhibitions include Setouchi Triennale, Japan, 2013; Drunk Versus Stoned, Neon Parc, 2013; Wrong Formalism, Sutton Gallery, Fitzroy, 2012; Primavera, Museum of Contemporary Art, Sydney, 2010 and in 2013 he was Asialink Australia's representative at Setouchi Triennale. Slattery has participated in several residency's including ISCP New York, 2013, Gertrude Contemporary Art Spaces, Melbourne, 2008-10 as well as the Sammlung Lenikus Programme, Vienna, 2012.
